RIGOROUS AND PRAGMATIC

BIOGRAPHY

Maxime Tach grew up on the family wine estate. Over ten years, he gained experience in the Graves wine region, where he learned the basics of vineyard management working alongside his father.

His fondness for white varieties led him firstly to Château Haut-Brion, where he developed a knowledge of the special ecosystem of the white variety terroirs and most particularly of how to manage the soils' water reserves.

Having followed general subjects in his studies, Maxime graduated in 2011 with a degree in biology and then in 2013 obtained his Diplôme National d'Œnologue at Bordeaux's ISSV. His professional career began at Château La Fleur de Bouïard in 2012 working alongside Philippe Nunes, where he learned the values of rigour and precision in the wine cellars.

Maxime's career continued its development on Bordeaux's right bank when in 2015 he was taken on at Château Grand Ormeau in Lalande-de-Pomerol as technical manager. Over the following two years, he deepened his knowledge of the right bank, before joining the Hubert de Bouïard and Philippe Nunes consultancy team in 2017 as a winemaking consultant.

The desire to make his own wine with his family remained close to his heart, and his wish was subsequently fulfilled. His attachment to the family-run vineyard has provided him with an intimate knowledge of the technical and economic challenges faced by vigneronns.
